

Dan Gaffner is associate professor and senior lecturer at Lund University, Department of Building Physics. He earned a Master of Science/Diploma in Civil engineering from the Chalmers University of Technology in 1968 and was appointed assistant professor 1974 in Building Technology at Lund University 1976, later promoted to associated professor/senior lecturer. He served as Vice Dean of the School of Architecture in Lund University from 1982-1993 and Administrative Head of the Department of Building Science 1990-1993. He has published scientific papers in the area of moisture transport in building materials. Between 1998-2007 he has served as program secretary in the national Research Program Competitive Building which comprised more than 30 research students and collaborated with more than 15 construction companies.
